

KETTERING v. LUTON.

On Christmas Day Luton journeyed to Kettering in search of League points. Dull weather prevailed, but 5,000 people were present at the match. Kettering, with the wind in their favour, attacked hotly in the first half, and Roulstone scored from a free-kick after 30 minutes' play. Mid-way through the second half Webb added a second goal for Kettering from a penalty. The visitors were very unlucky, for after losing a goal from a free-kick, scored at the expiration of half an hour, they had both Lindsay and Holdstock badly injured, and practically finished with nine men.
