LUTON RESERVES v. ROTHWELL.

LUTON LOSE THE CHAMPIONSHIP.

This match, which was the last of the Luton fixtures in this League, took place at Rothwell on Saturday before a good attendance in wet weather. This match decided the championship for the season. Luton had not been defeated in the League until Saturday, but they have made four draws, while Rothwell have only been defeated once—and that curiously enough was at Luton—and have only lost two points, while Luton have lost six. Rothwell have come on with a rush towards the finish, but the fact that they have only had to meet the Reserves of stronger clubs, has alone given them championship honours, as with the exception of Finedon, they are almost the weakest club in the League. In the match under notice, the Luton team never had a lock in, it being a case of the Luton defence and the Rothwell forwards. The result of a one-sided game was the defeat of Luton Reserves by 8 goals to nil, the severest defeat that the Luton men have sustained this season.
