NEW BROMPTON v. LUTON.

This match, played at Gillingham on Monday, resulted in a victory for Luton by 3-1, not by 4-1 as stated in some quarters.

New Brompton: Metherell; Webb and Floyd; Lissenden, Walker and Elliott; Hartley, Cunliffe, Lee, Lunn and Marriott.

The home forward line was pretty strong but the defence was weakened by the inclusion of several reserves. The game was interesting but not at all of an exciting character Gittins gave Luton the lead but Lunn equalised and half-time came with the scores equal. In the second period Barnes notched another point from Schofield's centre and Gittins gained a legitimate goal from a difficult angle but it was disallowed. Another centre by Schofield resulted in Brown putting on the last point.

The exchanges in the first half were fairly even but in the second the Luton forwards settled down much better than they have done in some recent matches and played very good combination. Schofield showed up very prominently and he and Warner worked together better than they had ever done before.
