NORWICH v. LUTON.

Yesterday (Thursday) Luton journeyed to Norwich in connection with the above League and without the services of R. Hawkes, Platt and Brown suffered defeat to the tune of 4—0. Norwich had the assistance of T. Fitchie, the Scottish International, but he did not shine against the Luton defence. Norwich were generally more dangerous, and Ronaldson scored twice before the interval. The second goal, however, we deflected out of Farr's reach by McCurdy. On restarting the second half Norwich continued to press and claimed that Farr had cleared when the ball was over the line, but the referee held otherwise. Norwich not to be denied still kept pegging away and were awarded a free kick from which Ross scored the third. The Luton forwards were now showing up well and Pickering made several good but ineffectual attempts to beat the home goalie. Norwich again took up the attack and Chalmers put on the last goal with a good shot, Luton thus losing a keen game by 4—0.
