LUTON v. NORWICH CITY.

Played at Luton before a small crowd on Monday afternoon. Result:—

While Luton had out somewhat of a scratch eleven, Norwich were fully represented with the exception that King, a local lad, appeared at inside left instead of Davy Ross. There were three other ex-Lutonians on the City side, in Thompson, McEwen and Lamberton.

Four minutes after the kick-off Gittins scored with a brilliant shot and fifteen minutes later Pickering added another. At the interval, Luton led by 2—0. Fifteen minutes after the resumption Wood obtained an off-side point. Pickering added another legitimate goal from a centre by Latheron, Barnes broke through on his own account and scored and Pickering completed Luton's list with another fine one. In the last minute, Ronaldson reduced the lead and the end arrived with Luton leading by 5—1.

Needless to say, the homesters were the better team but were not four goals superior. Taken altogether, their display was an excellent one but they might with a little care and due consideration of all their chances have added a few more points.
