

WESTERN LEAGUE.

LUTON V. BRISTOL ROVERS.

Played at Luton on Monday, resulting in a draw of one goal each after a dull, uninteresting game. Mr. F. Townsend (Leamington) was referee and the teams were:—Luton: Platt; McCurdy and Dimmock; F. Hawkes, White and Watkins; Rigate, Pearson, Rankin, Moody and Latheron. Bristol: Cartlidge; Hales and Shapcott; Smart, Appleby and Strang; Clark, Savage, Farrington, Gerrish and Murphy. None of the players on the home side exerted themselves with the exception of Fred Hawkes and McCurdy; yet Luton were the superior team up to the interval, though a mistake of Platt's gave Bristol the lead just before lemon time. A very weak shot by Savage was muffed by the home goalkeeper who put the ball over the line himself and the elevens crossed over with the Rovers one goal to the good. In the second half play was just as dull but immediately before the finish Fred Hawkes equalised and the finish came with the clubs sharing the points.
