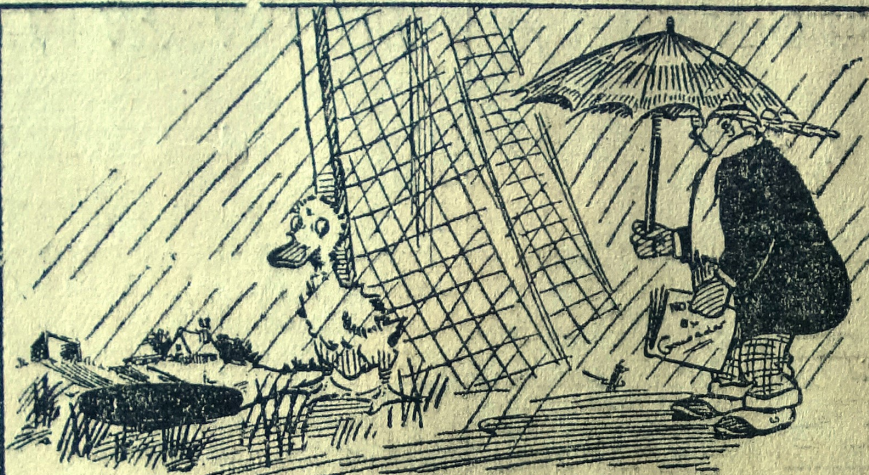




EASTVILLE, OR RATHER MUDVILLE, BRISTOL, IS A LOW LYING
