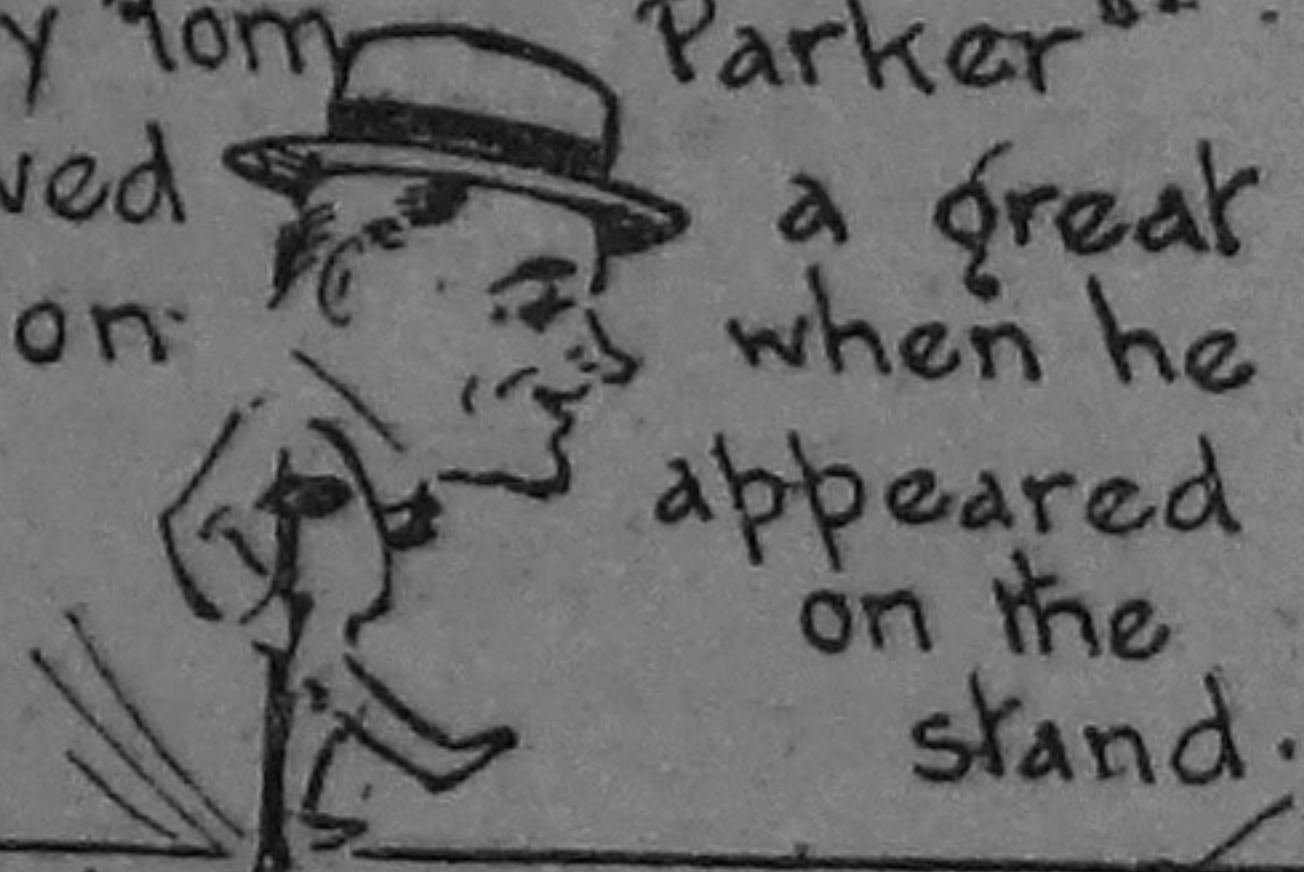


Evidently the wounded soldier

advantage!"

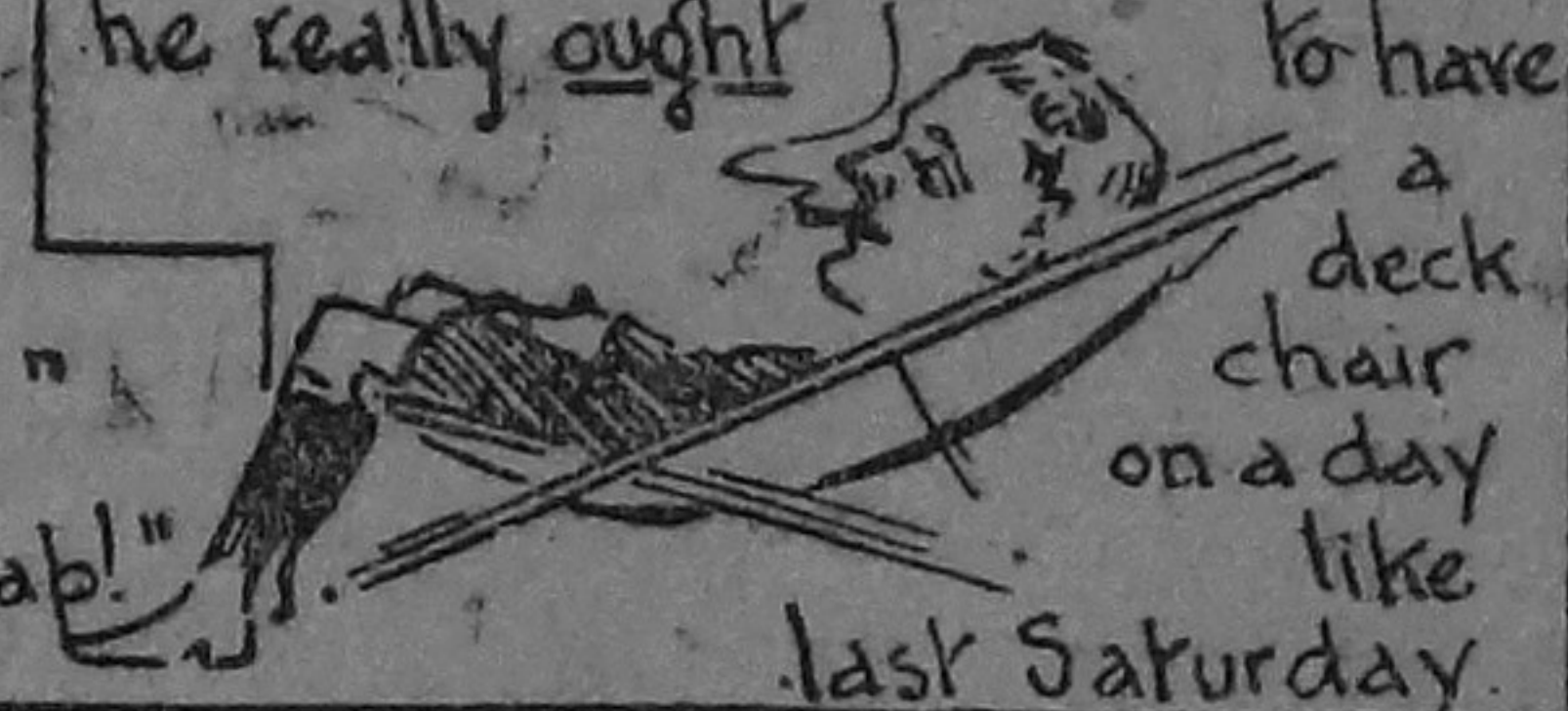

he really ought to have



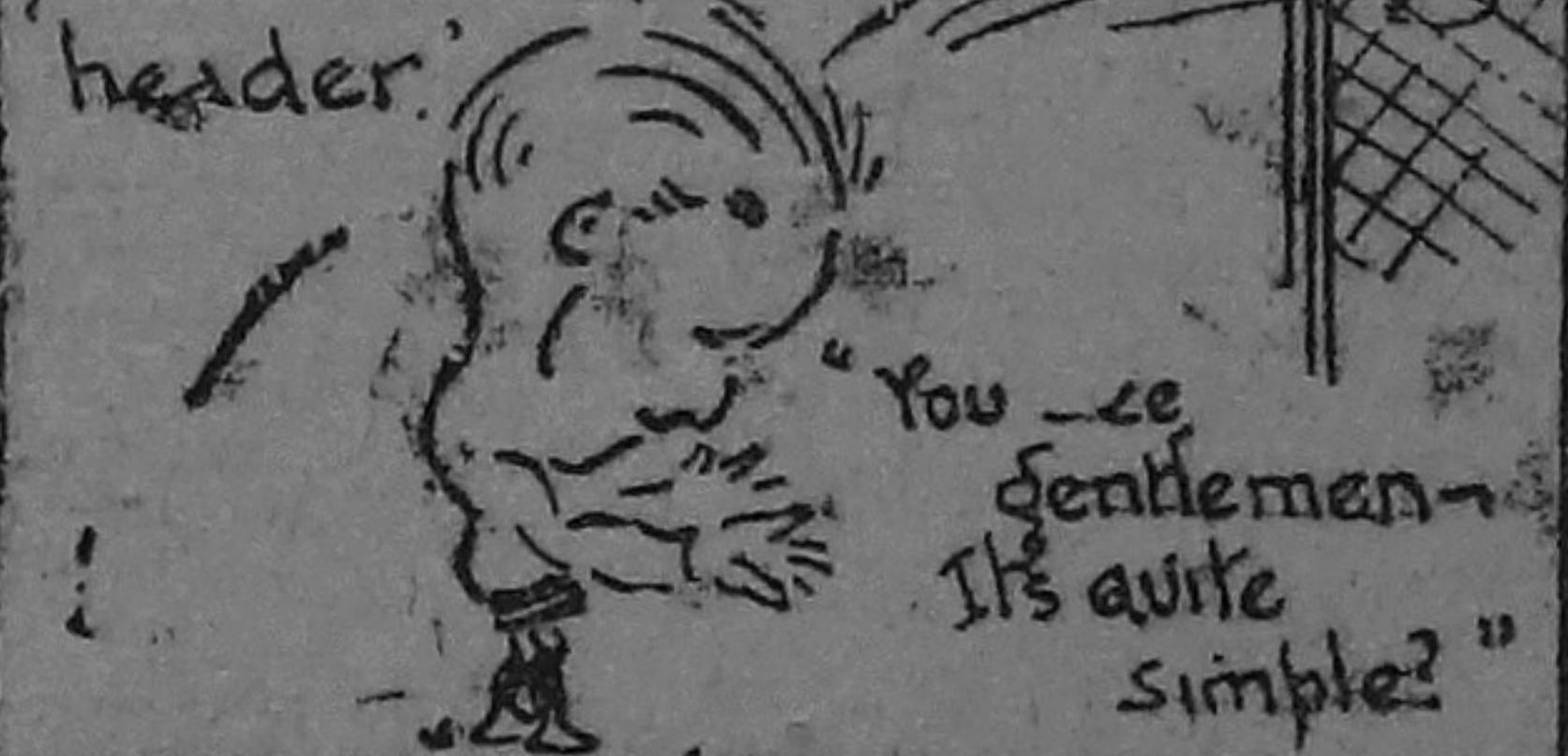
