

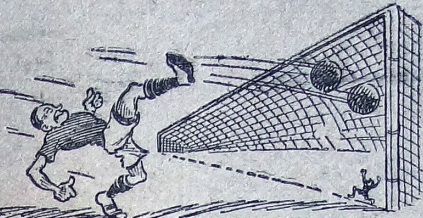

DOWN WITH A PAIR OF SCORCHERS



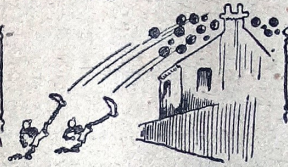
AND WITH ONE SLIGHT TOUCH OF IMAGINATION WE CAN
