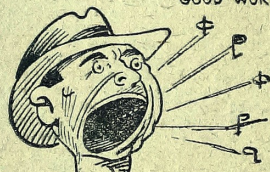
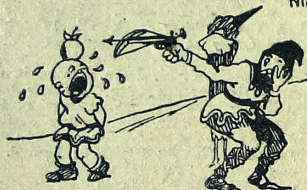


IF THERE ARE ANY SCOTSMEN
