TO DAY WHEN A LUTON FORWARD TRIES A SHOT HE MERELY GRASPS THE

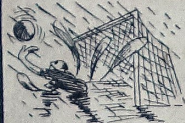

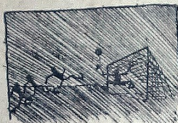
