

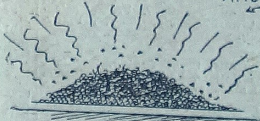
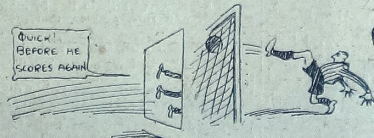
AND YET AGAIN!
