The directors were faced with a hospital full of trouble on Thursday morning. The holiday games played havoc, and yesterday morning Orr, Jennings and Hoar were declared impossible, while Butcher was an unknown quantity in the matter of fitness, but it was extremely unlikely that he would be able to play. All the injured men have made heroic attempts to get fit, but, unless marvellous recovery is made within a few hours they are not likely to turn out. So Prentice seems the only possible player for the right wing position, and Percy Clarke will be given a chance at inside-left if Butcher is not fit. With the Cup-tie ahead risks are

usually avoided by wise clubs, but here the directors have no option. Clarke has done well, and the crowd will be pleased to see the Luton boy take the field.

Southend have a good side out, though perhaps not their best. Gibson is the old Notts Forest man, and so he will be facing an old colleague in Green. Of late the "Shrimpers" have not done very well, and they fared badly in their last three games, drawing twice at home and losing by 5-2 at Aberdare on Boxing Day.

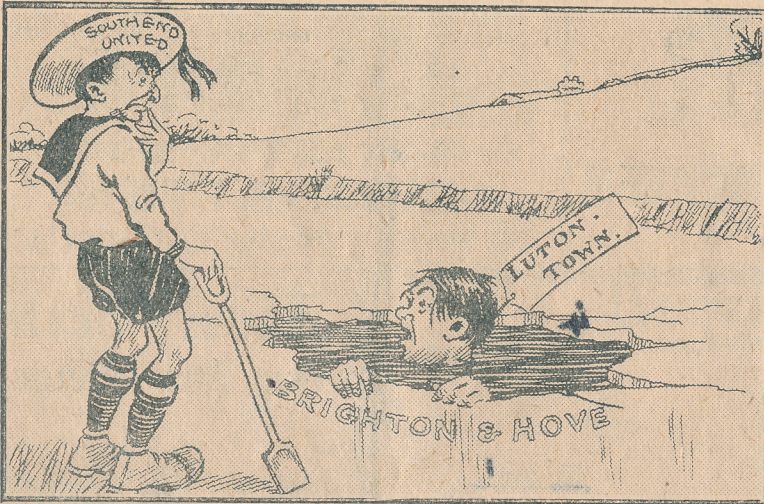

It was Christmas Day, 1922, when the Town had four goals scored against them prior to Wednesday last. Queen's Park Rangers did it then, winning by 4-0.

Ian Dickson, the Aston Villa centre-forward, who played against Luton Town in the Cup-tie, scored a hat-trick in his third game for Middlesbrough. On the same day the Villa lost by a goal to nil.

Bradford have never been defeated in the first round of the F.A. Cup. They will find difficulty in maintaining that record this season, for they go to Swindon.

The death took place at his residence, Haddon-avenue, New Moston, on Wednesday night, of Joseph Walters. Aged 37, he was an inside forward, and played for Aston Villa, Oldham Athletic, Millwall Athletic, Southend United, and Rochdale, and only last month he signed on for Crewe Alexandra, and was selected to play against New Brighton. But he had an attack of influenza, which developed into pneumonia. He leaves a wife and three children.

Thompson, the Reading right-half, who was with Torquay United last season, has been suspended for two months for misconduct in the game at Southend three weeks ago.

Northampton had not had a goal scored against them at home this season until Crossley did it for Swindon on Thursday

The suggestion that the venue of the F.A. Cup-tie between Aston Villa and Ashington on January 12th be changed from Ashington to Newcastle United's ground has been definitely rejected by the directors of the Ashington club. Ashington's supporters have yet to watch a F.A. Cup-tie, other than in the preliminary rounds and the directors of the club felt that to deprive them of the opportunity of witnessing a team of the calibre of Aston Villa would be an exceedingly bad policy. Certain temporary adjustments will be made at Portland Park, which will have the effect, it is hoped, of extending the accommodation for 20,000 spectators—a gate which would at least satisfy the home club.

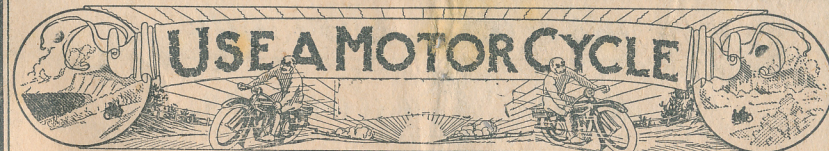

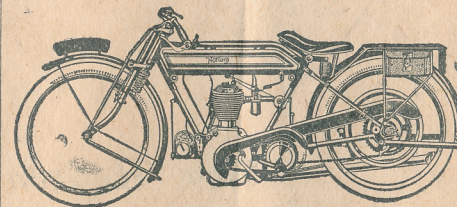
