THE CUP TIE IN THE SNOW!



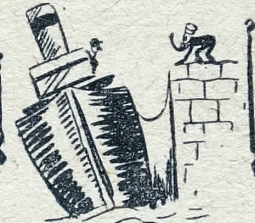
FOLKESTONE, I BELIEVE, OF MAY WITH DAISIES
