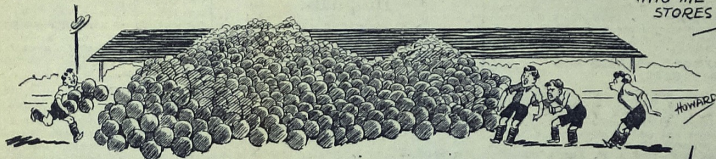
WITH THE TOWN IN THE MOST CONSIDERATE WAY ASSISTING THEM, UNTIL SOMEONE MUST HAVE
