

GOALS FROM RIGHT WING.

What Torquay could not achieve with combined rushes they accomplished with individual efforts, and it was after 25 minutes that Hutchinson beat Hurford following a dash by Dinkett on the right.

Luton's equaliser was also the result of a right-wing endeavour, McNeatry combining with Armstrong to outwit Hill. McNeatry moving in to score a capital goal.
