

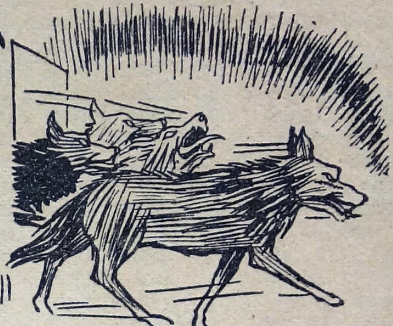

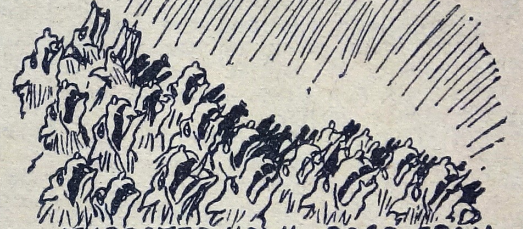
ALTHOUGH SOME OF 'EM LOOKED
