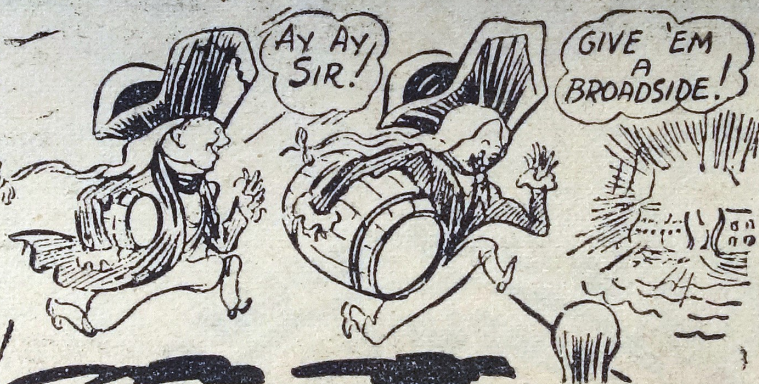
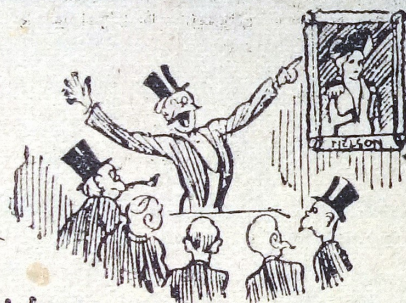


GILLINGHAM'S TRAFALGAR!
