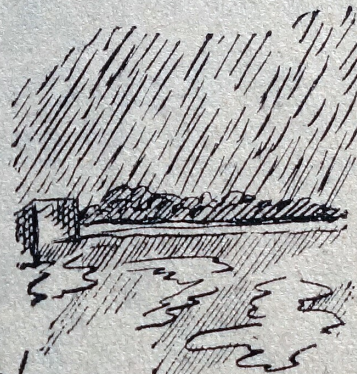


Monday Football
