

THREE GOALS FOR RENNIE

Luton have an Inspired Period & Swindon Go Under

Save for a hectic 15 minutes, when Luton overwhelmed their defence, Swindon played well and were equal to the home team until the interval, though Rennie had scored the only goal. When Swindon equalised, however, within a minute of re-starting through Brooks, Luton prevailed.

Nelson restored the lead. Mills twice converted centres from Rowe, and Rennie again netted from Rowe's pass. Near the end Wilkins reduced the lead, but Rennie again scored. Luton's attack played well, in spite of injury which kept Nelson off the field for 20 minutes.

Brown was quite the equal of McGinnigle and Fraser at half, while both backs covered Imrie finely. Briggs did well in Swindon's goal, and Girvan was a useful back, but the halves were more vigorous than skilful. Wilkins and Starsmore were their best forwards.
