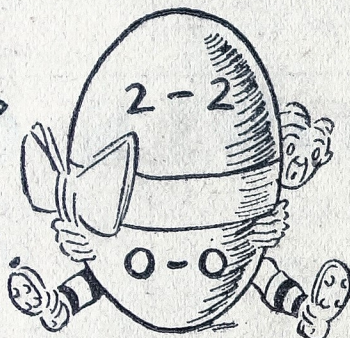


The "Lions" at Luton

Some of us have been in training

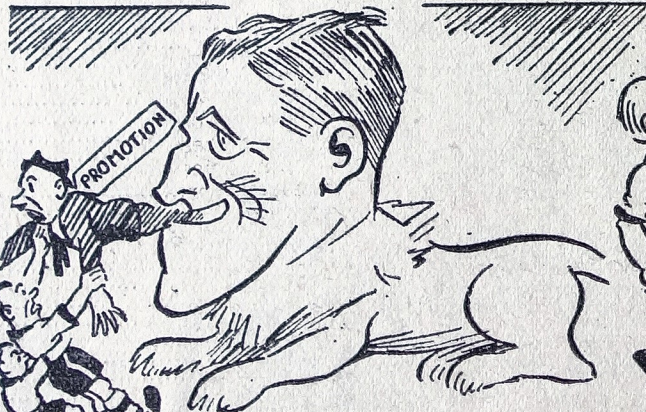

on Sary they were but a shadow of their real selves-



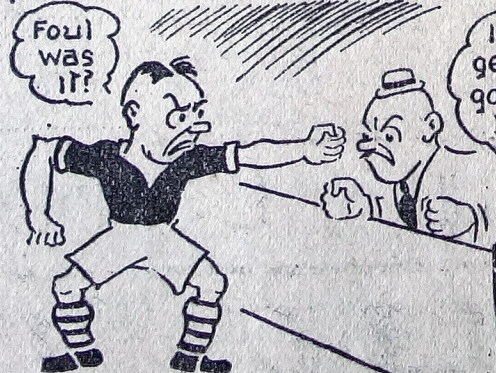
—the Lions led by Forsyth just about polished off their chances.

but their 'G' Men held up many raids.



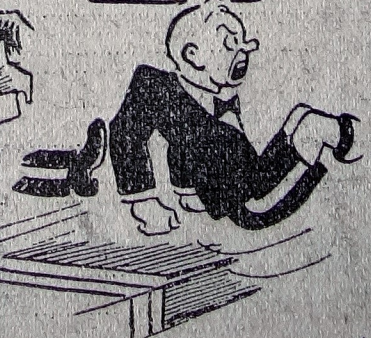
