LUTON showed only rare glimpses of their best form, and against a grim and determined defence almost petered out in the second half. The City chiefly concentrated on defence, but they had dangerous raiders in Williams and his wingers.

Luton were strangely inconsistent, and while they outplayed the City on occasions, they were at times at their worst in front of goal. Payne missed several easy chances.

Stephenson scored an early goal, and in the second half Williams and Owen put the City ahead, but Payne saved the game for Luton with a grand goal shortly before the end. Then only a heroic defence prevented Luton adding to their score.

Luton, who dropped a point at home for the first time this season, lacked spirit.
