

FOR the second season in succession we entertain the "Lions" for the second match of our Easter Programme, but let our first word be one of congratulation to a team which has made football history by winning through to the semi-final tie of the F.A. Cup. It is well realised that a club who reaches this stage must have a certain amount of good fortune and perhaps in the "Lions" case they can claim good hunting in the venues of their ties. However in spite of this there must be ability also and to defeat such clubs as Fulham, Chelsea, Derby County and Manchester City, even if on their own enclosure, definitely points to this end. Millwall you have our best wishes for your further success in this competition, but for a faux pas by ourselves when we met Sunderland, you might have been playing us at Huddersfield (or Arsenal) on April 10th. Anyhow here's wishing you what we could not do ourselves.

In addition to their successful Cup run, the "Lions" can boast of a good record in the League. But for failures at home they would have been in a much more unique position, for they have yielded both points at home on no fewer than five occasions. Bournemouth and Boscombe scored twice without reply and Reading and ourselves did likewise, whilst Bristol Rovers and Southend United obtained the odd goal in three. In addition to this, Notts County and Torquay United have each taken away with them one point. To counterbalance this deficiency somewhat the "Lions" have been successful at

Aldershot, winning by two goals to one, and also by a similar score over Newport County. Queens Park Rangers were defeated by one goal to nil at Shepherds Bush, whilst the "Lions" went one better at Torquay and one better still at Walsall. Drawn games resulted from their visits to Brighton. Exeter City, Northampton, Notts County, Southend and Watford. It will thus be seen that Millwall are a team of surprises, always accomplishing the unexpected, so we must be all out if we are to defeat them today.

The "Lions" retained only fifteen of last season's players, newcomers to their ranks including George Burditt from Notts Forest, David Mangnall and Thomas Inns from West Ham United, Gilbert Wassell from from Blackpool, Sydney Moffatt from Birmingham, Robert Thomas from Barnsley, John Burke from Chester, Kendall Burditt from Norwich, Gavin Mallock from Sheffield Wednesday, Ernest Steele from Notts County and Donald Barber from Bradford Park Avenue.
