We extend to Clapton Orient a hearty welcome on their visit here today, and also hope that their vicissitudes have now arrived at a more favourable stage. Next season will once again see them in pastures new, for they have taken on a lease of the Leyton Football Ground, a very fine enclosure. They have had not a few worries in the past, but they have always managed to turn up smiling, thanks to that band of football sportsmen, who generally come to the fore and take upon themselves the onus of directorship, when things are down in the dumps. The directors of the Clapton Orient Club can truthfully be classed in this category and they have the admiration of all those who are aware of the hardships they have had to face. With the acquisition of the new ground at Leyton perhaps their luck will change. Let us hope that it does so.

The "O's" have a very creditable record this season and although perhaps they cannot be looked upon as contenders for the championship they have proved a thorn in the flesh of many clubs and have upset promotion aspirants wholesale. At the time Bournemouth were going great guns, they inflicted a reverse upon them at Lea Bridge Road, and the same medicine was the fate of Brighton on the occasion of their visit, whilst Notts County could only garner one point from their match at the County Ground. Drawn games seems to have been their favourite result for the "O's" have eleven to their credit, more than any other Club in the Division.

The following are a few notes of their probable players here today.

**Hillam** (Goal) Now in his fourth season with the Orient and a much sought after player. One of the most brilliant keepers in the 3rd Division, has a wonderfully safe pair of hands and quick judgment. Never gives an indifferent display, and when the opposition is keen can always be relied upon to give a thrilling display with spectacular saves. Has seen service with Burnley and Manchester United. Height 5ft. 10in. Weight 11 st. 10lb.

**Searle** (Right Back) The Orient's Skipper. Has come right back to form after a cartilage operation at the beginning of the season. Height 5ft 11 in. Weight 12 stones.

**Hearty** (Left Back) A newcomer from Cardiff. Lives up to his name. Looks like developing into one of the toughest defenders ever been on the Orient books. Still a youngster with plenty of time to make his mark. Height 5ft. 10 in. Weight 12 stones.

**Taylor, H.** The Orient's utility man. Reached North-East London from Southport three seasons ago as an inside forward. When injuries have created team problems he has played in every position except goal. Height 5ft. 9in. Weight 11 st. 2lb.

**Affleck** (Centre Half) Has been sought after by many League Clubs. Ideally built for the position, came from Bristol City and has solved the problem created by the transfer of Fellowes to Luton. Height 6ft. Weight 12 st. 6lb.

**Heinemann** (Left Half) Plays well on either wing and never eases up throughout the whole ninety minutes. Has given the Orient yeoman service since they secured him from Crystal Palace. Always gives the impression he enjoys his football. Height 5 ft. 10 in. Weight 12 stones.

**McCombe** (Outside Right) A Scot with speed and all their wiles. Last season with Clyde. Knows the short cut to goal. Height 5 ft. 6 in. Weight 10 st. 4 lb.

**Fletcher** (Inside Right) Secured last season from Queens Park Rangers. Not much of a goal getter, but a real schemer. Height 5 ft. 8 in. Weight 11 st. 10 lb.

**Crawford** (Centre Forward) The Orient's record goal scorer as the result of his achievements last

season. Another utility player, can play just as well on the left wing, but prefers centre forward. Previously played for Liverpool and Halifax. Height 5 ft. 11 in. Weight 12 st. 6 lb.

**Smith, H.** (Inside Left) His third season with the Orient and a clever player in either of the inside positions. Dribbles a ball close in the approved Scottish fashion. Joined the Orient from Dundee. A powerful shot. Height 5 ft. 8½ in. Weight 11 stones.

**Farrell** (Outside Left) Has been with the Orient for three seasons and appeared at inside right, inside left, centre forward, left half and outside left. A brainy player. Came from Preston North End. Height 5 ft. 11 in. Weight 12 stones.
