

REFEREES' POSER.

Was it Interference?

A young referee writes:—"The outside-left centred the ball from behind an attacking colleague, who was standing dead level with the opposing back in an offside position, but he was not interfering with play, and did not move until the ball was handled by the back. This defender jumped up to head the ball but finding he could not do so, tried to stop it with his hand.

"At the same instant, the forward, realising that the back was missing the ball, stepped forward. The ball, after being handled by the back, dropped in front of the forward, and thus put him onside. I allowed play to proceed. However, I have now decided that the close proximity of the attacker to the back actually caused him to handle the ball, and therefore the attacker was off-side, as he was interfering with play. "

In reply if the forward was not interfering with play, as the correspondent contends was the case then the correct decision was a penalty against the back. That would have covered the matter.


