

TODAY we entertain Newport County and their visit will doubtless be welcomed by the large number of the natives of the "Leek Country" now resident in Luton. Accordingly they are assured beforehand of a vociferous reception.

The County have had rather a hectic season. For a long period at the commencement they were occupying the wooden spoon position; victory would not come their way, but with the acquisition of a number of well-known players they are gradually making themselves safe from the burden of having to obtain re-election. Their defeat at home at the hands of Walsall on Saturday last was a surprise, so doubtless they will be all out today to wipe off this blot from their escutcheon. The following is a short history of their players on duty.

John (goalkeeper) Signed a few weeks ago from Manchester United. Has played for Wales on several occasions. Previously with Walsall.

Williams (right full back) Another Welsh International and one who has also captained his country when the Welsh team gained the triple crown.

Webb (left full back) Signed from Exeter this season. Has played in several games at left half back which position seems to be preferable.

Edwards (right half back) A recruit, having joined the County's ranks this term from Crystal Palace. A very useful skirmishing defensive player.

Low (centre half back) Is Newport's best half back and hails from the North-East Coast. His father was an English International in prewar days

Hall (left half back) A recruit recently signed from Coventry City this term.

Duggan (outside right) A further recruit and also an Irish International. Was transferred from Burnley. Is the County's most dangerous forward and has paved the way for the majority of Newport's goals.

Sullivan (inside right) A Monmouthshire League product. Only signed "pro" forms a few weeks ago.

Derrick (centre forward) A native of Newport and a very dangerous forward at close quarters. Several well known clubs are interested in this player.

Wood (inside left) Signed this term from Aston Villa. Has a powerful long range shot.

Thomas (outside left) Has played against Luton on several occasions. Although now approaching the veteran stage still plays delightful football. A Welsh International.
