#### **CLUB NOTES** by "Hatter

FOR the opening match of our Easter Programme we have as our visitors our old rivals Southampton. Although they have not been so successful this season as they would have desired or as perhaps they expected to be before the season commenced, they have nevertheless many outstanding results to their credit. They can claim three victories on foreign soil having defeated Millwall by one goal to nil at the Den, Notts Forest by two goals to nil at the City Ground, and on Saturday last, Swansea vanquished before them at the Vetch Field by three goals to one. In addition drawn games of one goal each have resulted from their visits to Fulham, Tottenham Hotspur and Tranmere Rovers. Like ourselves it is their home points which have failed them, Blackburn Rovers, Coventry City, Manchester City and Tottenham all came away with their full quota, whilst Bury, Millwall. Newcastle United, Notts Forest and Sheffield United earned a division of the spoils. Last season the "Saints" defeated us here by three goals to one, when, perhaps supporters will remember, Jack Lewis was injured in the first five minutes of the game and we were obliged to play with ten men thereafter.

I am afraid the defeat at Sheffield Wednesday rather diminished our chances of promotion, although our boys had quite as much of the game as the Wednesday, and the result does not do them justice. Two changes are made from this team today. Hugh Billington resumes at centre forward and Tony Carroll is given the extreme right berth.

The "Stiffs" have a very hard nut to crack at Coventry this afternoon, and will have to show much improvement on their game with Northampton Town Reserves, last Saturday, if they expect to come away with any spoils. Their team is:-Mayberry, Smith, Lutterloch, Campbell, Nelson, Loughran, Burgess, Gager, Vinall, Ferguson, Stevens.

The "A" team too, have a long trek today, Stamford being their destination, when it is hoped they will once again return to the winning fold. The team selected for duty is: Duke, Carr, Fletcher, Goodyear, Lewis, Wale, Clark, Scott, Fullarton, Hogg, A. E. Ward.

Early this week we added yet another youngster to our professional staff, Charles Joseph Ladd, of Tom Mackey's build, having signed on the dotted line. Charles hails from Plaistow, which fans will have noted was the home town of Charlie Fraser.





### Something of Interest for Football Supporters to Read.

Four years ago the popular Bobbers Stand Club was formed, and during this period we have erected the popular Bobbers Stand and the Oak Road Stand which gives shelter and comfort to the shilling supporter.
