CLUB NOTES by "Hatter"

TODAY marks the conclusion of Season 1938/9; one which we can look back upon as what might have been and then what has actually happened. For a long period we hovered just in the top half of the League Table always within striking distance of the championship and promotion honours until at Easter time we made a very strong bid to attain this objective. But it was not to be and so we now congratulate Blackburn Rovers and one of the Sheffield Clubs on the distinction they have accomplished and wish them well in their higher sphere of football. We cannot however, allow this opportunity to pass without a word of praise and thanks to our boys for the wonderful fight they have made and the excellent games we have been allowed to witness. With the same determination next term, promotion can be obtained. A word of praise too for the "Stiffs." What has been said about the first team can also be applied to them. Their games too have been very enjoyable and but for one or two lapses at home they also would have made a stronger bid for honours. The "A" team as well deserve our congratulation and here again honours would have been achieved but for adverse results during the last month. It is only fair to them however to say that their team undergoes more changes in personnel than either the first or second team and the policy so far as they are concerned is not the gaining of championships but the trying out of promising youngsters. Time alone will prove the wisdom or otherwise of this innovation.

For our final game we have with us our old friends and rivals Coventry City and what more favourable opposition could we desire. The remarks I have made in the above paragraph can be equally said about the "Bantams," for their record in Division II and the London Combination is identical to that of ourselves. Doubtless they

will endeavour to improve their position in 1939/40 and we shall be there too, hoping to stop them.

Now a word to all supporters. The Directors thank you all for the support you have given us during the season and although perhaps one or two attendances during the real winter months have fallen below par, perhaps the national affairs and the severe weather conditions have curtailed the activities of all except the most hardy and fervent ones among us. The Club never minds criticism, so long as it is fair and not abusive, and also enjoys your praise when it is forthcoming and deserving. The management is always open to receive suggestions for the improvement of the Club and the amenities of the spectator, and although these may never be put into practice, you have our assurance that they will be fully considered. A final word, thank you all, players and supporters, for a successful season.

IMPORTANT

It has come to the knowledge of the Directors that many supporters, who travel to the matches here from the neighbouring towns and villages, have often cause for complaint as to the inadequacy and infrequency of the rail and/or road transport. This seems to be more especially so during the period when the Kick-Off must be fixed for 2.30 p.m.

Will all spectators who have any complaint whatsoever in this respect please write to the Secretary, Luton Town Football Club, Kenilworth Road, Luton, giving the particulars, when the club will take the matter up with the transport services concerned and endeavour to find a remedy.

The Directors appreciate very much indeed the material already forwarded by certain supporters, but would urge the necessity from other complainants, if a case is to be made.

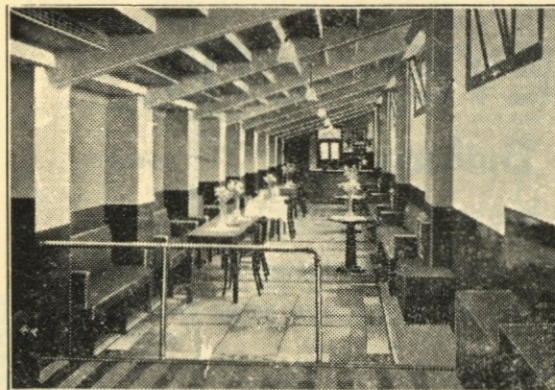
