FOR the second leg of our first round in the F.A. Cup we have Luton Town as visitors and extend to them a cordial reception.

Except for one period in the second half when our defence was hard pressed, prior to the fourth goal, the "Rams" gave a grand exhibition of scientific football which was much appreciated by the sporting Luton crowd. One change at least will have to be made to-day as Tim Ward, our left-half, who has shown good form while on leave, returned to his unit in Germany immediately after the game last Saturday.

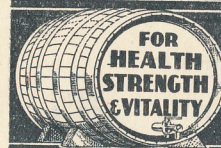

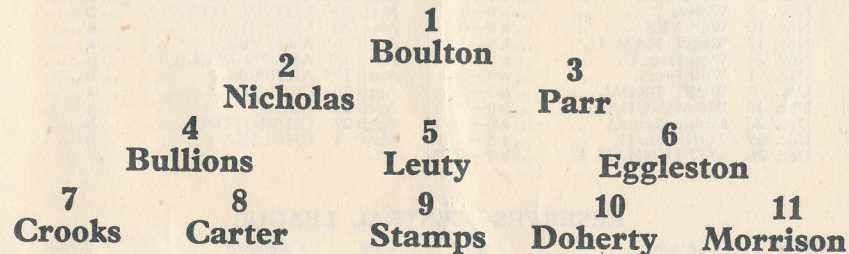

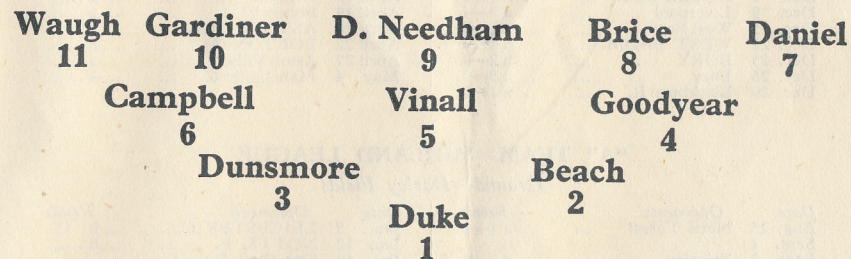
