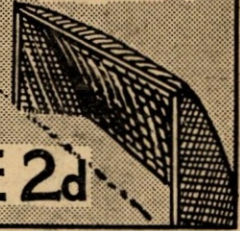

"The celebration of the Anniversary of the battle of El. Alamein will be held at The Royal Albert Hall, Kensington, London, commencing at 6.30 p.m., on Wednesday, 23rd October, 1946.

President: Field Marshal The Viscount Montgomery of Alamein, G.C.B., D.S.O.

Guest of Honour: The Right Honorable Winston Churchill.

Address by Field Marshal Montgomery.

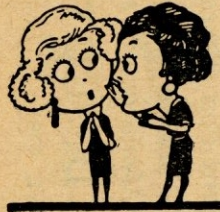
