#### CLUB NOTES

Coventry City, our very welcome visitors this afternoon, need no introduction to our supporters as events during the past years have turned our meetings into real "Derby" games. Who does not remember those terrific struggles at the close of Season 1935/6 when three points from the two games would have meant promotion to us instead of the City?

The "Bantams" have a record very similar to ourselves in the League this Season. At Highfield Road where 18 games have been played they are practically invincible and the only team to win there was Burnley by three goals to one. Eight teams have forced them to yield half the spoils. Coventry by the way having made more draws at home than any other club in the League. The Combination Cup game with Coventry Reserves has been arranged for Wednesday next, April 30th, kick-off 6.30 p.m. This game may have a vital bearing on the winning of the Section for only one point divides our two teams at the top of the table.
