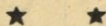

What a splendid display our lads gave at Plymouth last week. When Bobby Brennan scored his first goal only four minutes after the kick-off the final result was never really in doubt for our forward line had that extra zip which meant goals and the covering by our defence was excellent. So good was this covering, especially in the second half, that there appeared at times to be three white shirts to one green. What a pity only a small contingent was able to make the journey. Although small they made their presence felt, but even they could hardly credit the fact that we were one up in those first few minutes for it all looked too simple to be true. It was a chance beautifully taken by Bobby Brennan from a superb pass from Frank Soo which left the Inside Right with only the Goalkeeper to beat and when the ball was seen to be in the back of the net it was not until we saw the Referee walking back to the centre circle that we dared believe our eyes, and then those 150 stalwart supporters did give vent to their feelings in no uncertain manner. All our Players gave of their very best and the team spirit was wonderful, but there is one whom we should like to specifically mention (and we are sure the rest of the boys will not mind us doing so) and that is the splendid game given by Les Hall. It was a very big ordeal for his baptism into the senior side, but he came through with flying colours and hardly put a foot wrong. Altogether it was a great victory and well deserved. In passing we would like to mention the great sportsmanship shown by everybody in Plymouth. Officials of the Club, Players and Spectators alike all showed that they possessed this priceless gift, and every-

where we went, whether of the Official Party or of those 150 supporters, both before and indeed more so after the game, the welcome and that "glad to see you" feeling was very manifest. Thank you Plymouth for all you did for us.

We consider we have three bogey teams in the Second Division; Plymouth, Birmingham and Coventry, and here we are meeting these three teams in consecutive weeks. The first one has already been laid—what of the other two? Well today we have a chance of scotching the Birmingham bogey and next week, in the Fourth Round of the F.A. Cup we will do our best to scotch the Coventry one. We welcome Birmingham City to Kenilworth Road and trust to see an enjoyable match. Curiously enough our Reserve Team is playing their second string at Birmingham this afternoon.

With regard to next Saturday's Cup match with Coventry City all tickets were over-applied for in the first post. The demand is enormous and in order to meet this to some extent we are having entry to the whole of the Stand and Enclosure by ticket only. Coventry require the whole of their quota of tickets printed and we are already receiving quite a number of applications from Coventry supporters which is greatly adding to the mail. The Bobbers Stand Club are dealing with the majority of the 5/- Stand Enclosure Tickets and they will be on sale after this match and each day from 11 o'clock, but these tickets will only be sold on personal application at the Bobbers Club, which is in Beech Hill Path, and are not being sold at the Office in Kenilworth Road.

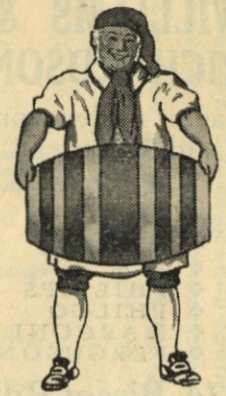
