We welcome Bradford to Kenilworth Road this afternoon in our first League game here since 17th January, a matter of five weeks. We have of course seen our first team in action since then when we beat Coventry on January 24th, in the Fourth Round of the F.A Cup, but even that was four weeks ago, so we expect a very special cheer will greet our lads as they enter the field this afternoon. We have now five matches at home out of the next six, so this should be enough entertainment for the most ardent fan, especially as such famous teams as Cardiff City and Sheffield Wednesday are included. Incidentally will you please note that the time of the kick-off against Sheffield Wednesday will be at 3 o'clock to enable our opponents to catch a train which will get them home on the Saturday evening. Bradford have unfortunately struck a bad patch lately, having suffered four defeats in succession, so they will be all out today to try and put an end to this state of affairs. They are always a very difficult team to beat and as our lads have every confidence in continuing the good work of last week when they beat Plymouth Argyle by three goals to one it should be a very interesting game.

We have been receiving numerous enquiries for Cup Final Tickets. In view of the fact that there seems to be a general impression that Clubs are receiving this year a much bigger allocation than in previous years we wish to state that we have this week received a letter from the Football Association informing us of the

number of Cup Final Tickets we may expect. It is exactly the same number as allocated to us last year. It is very small and already the number of applications received outnumber the tickets by almost five to one. It is a hopeless job, so supporters, please refrain from making any further applications as the answer is bound to be in the negative. We should very much like to satisfy all our customers all the time but when demand greatly exceeds supply then unfortunately quite a lot of people have to be disappointed.

We have had a letter from the Honorary Secretary of the Jubilee Committee of the West Ham Schools' Sports Association stating that in 1950 the Association will celebrate its Diamond Jubilee. Amongst other arrangements it is hoped to publish the full story of the sixty years endeavour, but for much of the material concerning the early days especially, reliance will have to be made on 'old Hammers' who still possess, besides their memories, old photographs (particularly pre 1900), programmes, press cuttings etc. Should any of you here today be able to help the West Ham Club in this way will you please communicate with Mr. J.
