

CLUB NOTES

WHEN the final score came through from Plymouth last Saturday, which meant that we had picked up another precious point, we all felt that our relegation fears were practically over. But when all the smoke after the Easter fixtures had died away we found we were even worse off than we were before the holiday, for all the teams below us picked up maximum points while we found ourselves on the losing side at Barnsley. So the struggle is by no means over yet, although with three home games out of our remaining four we should be able to put all doubts at rest before the last day of the season.

Our lads gave a splendid display of football at Barnsley, one of the best this season and were most unfortunate to come away empty handed. That a penalty should have been awarded to us when the ball was fisted over the bar by the Barnsley left back there was no doubt in anybody's mind who was present except the Referee. Everybody was amazed when he pointed to the corner flag for a corner to be taken, and despite strong appeals from our lads would not alter his decision. It is feasible to suppose that a goal would have been scored if a penalty kick had been taken and there is no doubt our lads would have finished on the right side after that for they were playing much the better football. Naturally our boys were very disappointed over this decision but they are to be congratulated on the sporting way in which they accepted the referee's decision.

On the same day at about the same time our Reserves were also appealing to the referee in charge. at Luton, but for quite a different reason, for in this case the ball had actually entered the net. Jimmy Jinks fired in a rasping shot which struck the iron support at the back of the net and came back on to the field of play. Jimmy could have hit it into the back of the net again on the rebound but simply turned his back on it to walk back to the centre of the field. He then noticed that the referee was waving play on, and when it dawned on him that a goal had not been given tried to back-heel the ball into the net but it went just wide of the post and the decision, despite appeals, was a goal kick. Naturally, the crowd let off steam at this decision but we do want to thank the spectators who were present for not allowing their feelings to run too high, and therefore avoiding any incident which would have been regretted later.
