

However that is one of the things a footballer has to put up with and is accepted in the best sporting way. We feel that having to travel all the way to Swansea and back, especially at this time of the year, is very bad arranging on someone's part, but there it is and we have to make the best of it.

And now for a Who's Who of our guests today:-

John Parry, Goal. Born Swansea and signed from local team. Selected to play for Wales against Scotland this season.

John Roberts, Right Back. Another local boy but secured from Bolton Wanderers this season. Played for Wales during their Tour 1948/49.

Gilbert Beech, Left Back. Secured from Merthyr Town, 1949, and converted to a full back this season. Born Tamworth, Staffs.

William Lucas, Right Half. Born at Newport. Mon. Joined Club from Swindon, 1948. Since departure of Roy Paul to Manchester City has been playing right half. Represented Wales during 1948/49 and this season played against England. Has also several War-time and Victory Internationals to his credit.

Reg. Weston, Centre Half. Joined Swansea in 1945 while serving in H.M. Forces-present Captain of side. Born Greenhithe, Kent. Made 37 first team appearances last season.

Dormel Williams, Left Half. Born Loughor (nr. Swansea), and secured from the Club of that name. Promoted from the reserve team this season.

Jack O'Driscoll, Outside Right. Born Cork, Eire. and joined Swansea during 1947/48 season. Capped for Eire and Ireland, 1948/49 season.

David Thomas, Inside Right. Came to Swansea as an amateur. Took over inside right position when Lucas moved to half back. Born Cymmer, Glamorgan.

Stan Richards, Centre Forward. Born Cardiff. Played for Tuffnell Park as an amateur. Joined Cardiff City as a professional and was later transferred to Swansea. Played for Wales v. England, 1948.

Ivor Allchurch, Inside Left. Local born. 21 years of age. Represented Wales against England at Sunderland this season and is regarded as one of the players with a great future.

Cyril Beech, Outside Left. Brother to Gilbert (left back) also secured from Merthyr. Made 37 appearances in first team last season.

In conclusion may we sincerely trust that the matches played by the "Hatters" this Xmastide have provided you with some good sporting fare and that 1951, just around the corner, will be a Happy and Prosperous Year for you all.


