

The Sparkle Lasted Only 20 Minutes

Swansea Town 4. Luton Town 2

One of the Town's luckier grounds in the past has been Vetch Field and they seemed to be steering to yet another victory here on Thursday night when they settled down right from the start.

Before Luton took the lead in 14 minutes when MOORE headed through from Cullen, the Swansea goal had had two narrow escapes and Pye had a goal disallowed.

The sparkle lasted for about 20 minutes—long enough for a match-winning lead to be established had there been real thrust in attack—and then Swansea began to take a hand.

Goals by MEDWIN and GRIFFITHS gave Swansea a 2—1 lead at half-time and there it remained until the closing minutes which brought a burst of scoring.

MEDWIN and GRIFFITHS increased the home lead in the space of three minutes and three minutes from the end, SCOTT, who had moved to centre-forward, replied for the Town.

After the fine start, there was rather a disappointing display from the Town who showed uncertainty in defence where Owen and Dunne were distinctly worried.

Best in this department were Morton and Aherne, and Watkins came into his own in the second half.

Pick of a moderate forward-line was Pye and the occasion was probably too much for Scott, who, however showed promise, especially when he switched to centre-forward.
