1. BAYNHAM, R. A worthy successor to Stretton and particularly competent with the high ball.
2. JONES, L. C. Made 3 appearances with the seniors last season and is fulfilling the high hopes placed in him by Manager Dally Duncan.
3. PEMBERTON, J. P. Born Brierley Hill, he made his debut in 1950-51 after joining Luton from Stourbridge as an outside left.
4. MORTON, R. H. A local discovery, Bob was born at Aston Clinton, Bucks., and formerly played for Eaton Bray and Waterlows.
5. HALL, L. F. Played only 3 games in the first team last season but is getting first class reports for some fine displays as a stopper pivot.
6. OWEN, S. W. Born Birmingham and better known as a grand centre half, this red haired left half joined Luton in 1947 and deservedly made the Australian tour in 1951.
7. CULLEN, M. J. A grand winger who has graduated after 2 appearances last season. Fast and forceful he is making a useful contribution to the current success of the Hatters.
8. TURNER, G. R. A grand opportunist inside forward who is regularly among the goals. His goal against Hull last Saturday was the reward for first class positioning and quick thinking.

Bury v. Luton Town

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

To-day is the commencement of our Easter programme which includes two away games, Lincoln and Luton. In spite of certain defects in the first half display last Saturday we have again put out an unchanged side with complete confidence and hope this afternoon to see further progress with a combination that has been undisturbed for the last six games.

The Central League side also pulled off a sound win at Derby with 2 good goals by Derick Maddox and one by Bob Dale, who incidentally showed some return to form.

Injured Frank Slynny, Walter Kelly, Don Wilson and Gordon Waring are all making good progress but what the lads think about Don Wilson's luck in the Lincoln and National is not printable.

To-days event with Luton has been eagerly awaited particularly as the side contains two players in whom we were keenly interested and one in particular resulted in our being "pipped on the post" after a long journey up North.

Apparently our judgment on the players concerned proved good and Luton have certainly had a great season, with quite a chance of overhauling Huddersfield at this stage. Playing good attacking football the experienced Jesse Pye has infused a spirit into the "Hatters" and recovered the form which brought him into prominence with Wolves. Hugh McJarow also a dangerous and bustling style player is alongside the former England forward and together with Mitchell, Turner and Cullen constitute a striking force which is capable of tearing holes in the most compact defence.

We regard this match as a challenge in styles with the duel between Les Hart and Jesse Pye a highlight. All things being equal and with complete knowledge of our task, we expect to take the points this afternoon but it must be in the words of captain Les Hart, "every man pulling together and helping each other."
