Town Found Goals Scarce On Their Lancashire Tour

Point out of four was a good deal worse result than the Town hoped for from their Easter tour of Lancashire, but a mere glance at the scores shows just how near they came to attaining their objective, which, putting it at its lowest, must have been three points.

complaint from any quarter had he decided in the Town's favour. Dunne was penalised when he ran across to cover when Crossan was through. The full-back reached the ball, touched it out of danger and Crossan went full length without, as I saw it, Dunne touching him at all.

Not Much Punch In Blackburn Attack
BLACKBURN deserved their lead, but this was a highly fortunate way of taking it, and while it would not be quite true to say that they seldom looked like scoring in the normal way, they had not sufficient punch to produce final finish capable of beating the brilliant Baynham. They were aggrieved when the referee on a linesman's prompt signal disallowed a goal obtained by Crossan. I was in no position to judge whether there was an offside offence here or not, but the linesman had no doubt about it, for his flag was raised high as Crossan began his run.

Thrills In The Last Five Minutes
THE last five minutes were as thrilling a spasm as we had in the match. From the Town forwards, who had shaken down into a more effective combination during the last 20 minutes, came one of the quickly developed movements that we had looked for in vain for so long. A mistake by the immaculate Eckersley let the Town right wing through and Davies, from Moore's pass, swept the ball low across the goal to Mitchell.

Without hesitation the outside-left took the ball in his stride, ran on and drove it firmly wide of Elvy's left hand into the corner of the net. Five minutes to go then, and visions of the Town snatching a dramatic victory that nearly became reality just before the finish.

Back Pass Nearly Gave Town A Victory
KELLY was going back towards his own goal with the ball when he suddenly decided to push the ball back to Elvy. It went wide of the goalkeeper and the crowd looked on aghast as it rolled tantalisingly towards the net.

Elvy made a very quick recovery to reach the ball on the very goal-line as Moore arrived a split second too late. Elvy smothered the ball and the Town's last chance of picking up the other point disappeared. Not that the excitement was over, for in the last seconds Crossan smashed in a terrific shot from point-blank range that Baynham saved extremely well.

Forwards Had Only Odd Good Spells
APART from odd spells, the Town forwards in neither match played football the easy way. Instead of using the open spaces and the quick pass, there was too much running with it, and the understanding that has been so obvious in many matches only peeped out on rare occasions.

At Bury, after those early stages, a goal to the Town seemed a rather remote possibility and, in the second half one of the few scoring shots that bore the "goal" tag came from Turner, who forced Kirk to make a brilliant save by pushing the ball over the bar.

Much more shooting came from Bury but neither in power nor direction did it worry Baynham unduly. **Goalless Draw Seemed Foregone Conclusion**
TWO or three times, though, he made sensational full-length

saves, but that this would be a goal-less draw seemed to be a foregone conclusion. That would have been a satisfactory result to the Town, who were expecting a hard struggle because of the somewhat dangerous position in which Bury were situated. To some extent this was reflected in their play, for they went in to meet everything and showed plenty of fighting spirit, allied to quite a sound defence and dash in attack.

There were only nine minutes to go and a point was within the Town's grasp when Bury obtained the goal that relieved a lot of their anxiety.

Week-End Honours Went To Defence
DURING a mix-up in front of goal, the ball rebounded off a Town defender to Cameron and he forced Baynham to go full-length at the near post and push the ball for a corner. This was fatal to the Town for Baynham failed to catch the ball as it came over.

Afterwards, Town defenders said that he had been impeded, but the referee did not share that view and the ball went loose to Gleadall, who made no mistake from a few yards out.

As can be judged from the results, the honours of the week-end went to the Town defence who did well to keep the debit side so low. **Baynham Made Some Great Saves**
APART from the slip that led to the goal at Bury, Baynham came through both matches without a blemish and gave further proof that he has every chance of reaching the top flight.

At Blackburn, in particular, he was in magnificent form, and time and time again his catching of high centres got the Town out of trouble. A very satisfactory showing this, and another who had every reason for satisfaction was Pemberton, one of the outstanding players on the field at Gigg-lane.

While he was not quite so prominent the following day, he was again cool and polished, but Campbell received rather too many scoring chances than should have come his way. Happily, he missed them. **Dunne Did Better At Blackburn**
DUNNE gave his better performance at Blackburn after an unsteady start in which he found Glover something of a problem.

Gradually, though, he gained the upper hand and was a good deal more confident and not so prone to wild clearances in the second half. A hard knock on the nose midway through the first half at Bury rather put Hall off his stroke and he was also upset by the way in which Plant backed into him as they went up for the ball, something which the referee apparently failed to see, judging by the free-kicks he gave against the centre-half.

However, there were pass marks for Hall in both matches and it is notable that neither centre-forward scored. **Much Hard Work From Wing Halves**
THERE was much hard work from Morton and Owen, with the former perhaps a little more consistent, and although Owen is doing well at left-half, he is not doing as well as he was when in the middle.

For one thing, he does not use the ball accurately enough, but there was nothing wrong with his defensive play in either match and he tried desperately hard to rally his forces. Pye was seldom out of the grip of Hart at Bury, and found Kelly a rugged opponent the following day. Yet it was when Pye was in possession that the Town looked most dangerous but, even allowing for the lack of support, this was not his best form.

Inside Forwards Did Not Fill The Bill
NEITHER Turner nor McJarrow—both of whom received slight knocks—really filled the inside-forward bill against Bury, but nor were Moore and Watkins any more effective the following day. Moore was a keen disappointment, for he missed vital chances again and not a lot came from Watkins. Davies was patchy, as Cullen had been at Bury, but Davies did try to raid and make ground quickly.

In each game, Mitchell began as if he would paralyse the defence but, somehow, never accomplished all that he promised. For 20 minutes or so, he had a complete mastery over Stuart, then fell away, possibly because less of the ball came his way, but also because Stuart's tackling improved and Mitchell did not come back again as a potent force until the closing stages.

Beat Formidable Opposition Twice
NOT many spectators expected a much-changed Town Reserve team to follow up their Good Friday defeat of Norwich with a victory over Ipswich yet, if anything, they gave a better display on Saturday, although the opposition was not quite of the same quality.

Strange thing about their two week-end victories was that they were over the two leading teams in the Football Combination, Section III, whereas, against less formidable opposition they have failed. On Saturday they got off to the best possible start with a goal from Bennett in the second minute, and eight minutes later Shanks, back to something like his pre-injury form, scored another after coolly beating two defenders in the Ipswich penalty area.

Aherne Had A Successful Test
IPSWICH replied through Dobson but in the second half Luton were well on top and added three more goals through Brown and Groves (2).

Bud Aherne also played strongly at left-back and appeared to come through the game without ill-effect. Against Norwich they did very well to beat an extremely useful side. Norwich scored first through Hansell but Scott equalised within two minutes and gave Luton the lead in the second half. Luton's third goal came from Allen, who played cleverly although he was hampered to some extent by lack of inches.

Moore led the line intelligently and Scott was often dangerous. Pick of the defence was left-back Thompson.

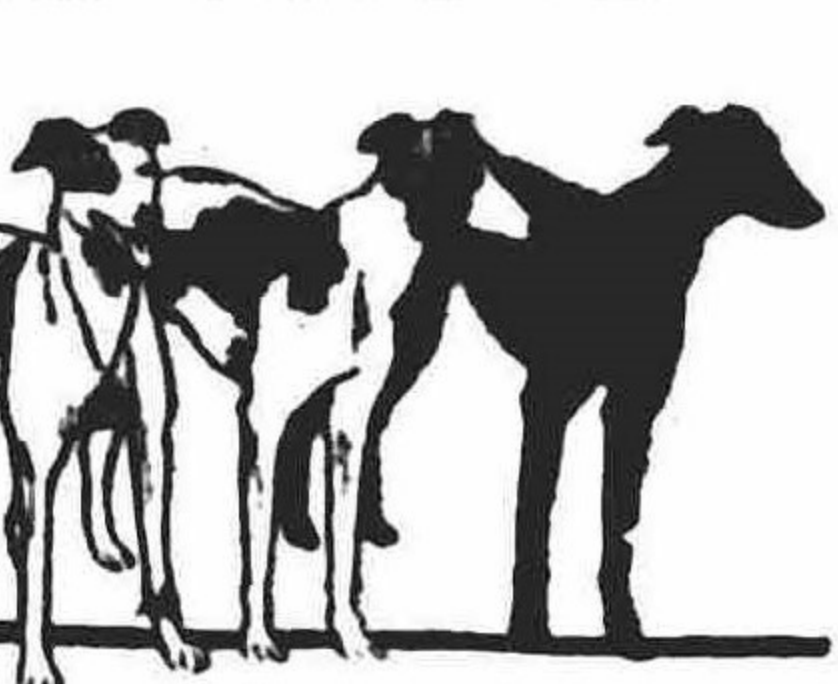
County Programme
