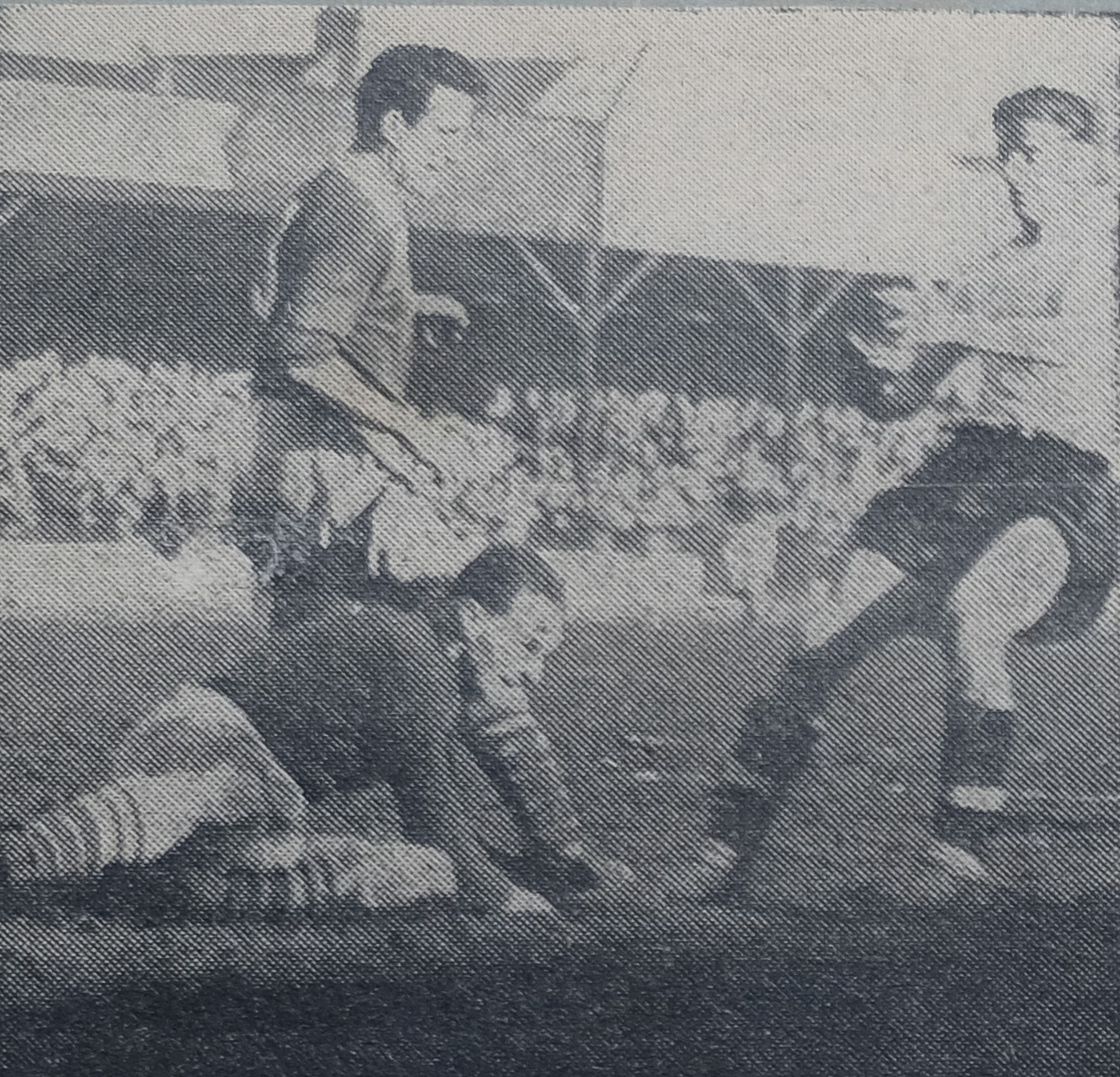


TOWN WIN, TOP DIV. II AGAIN
