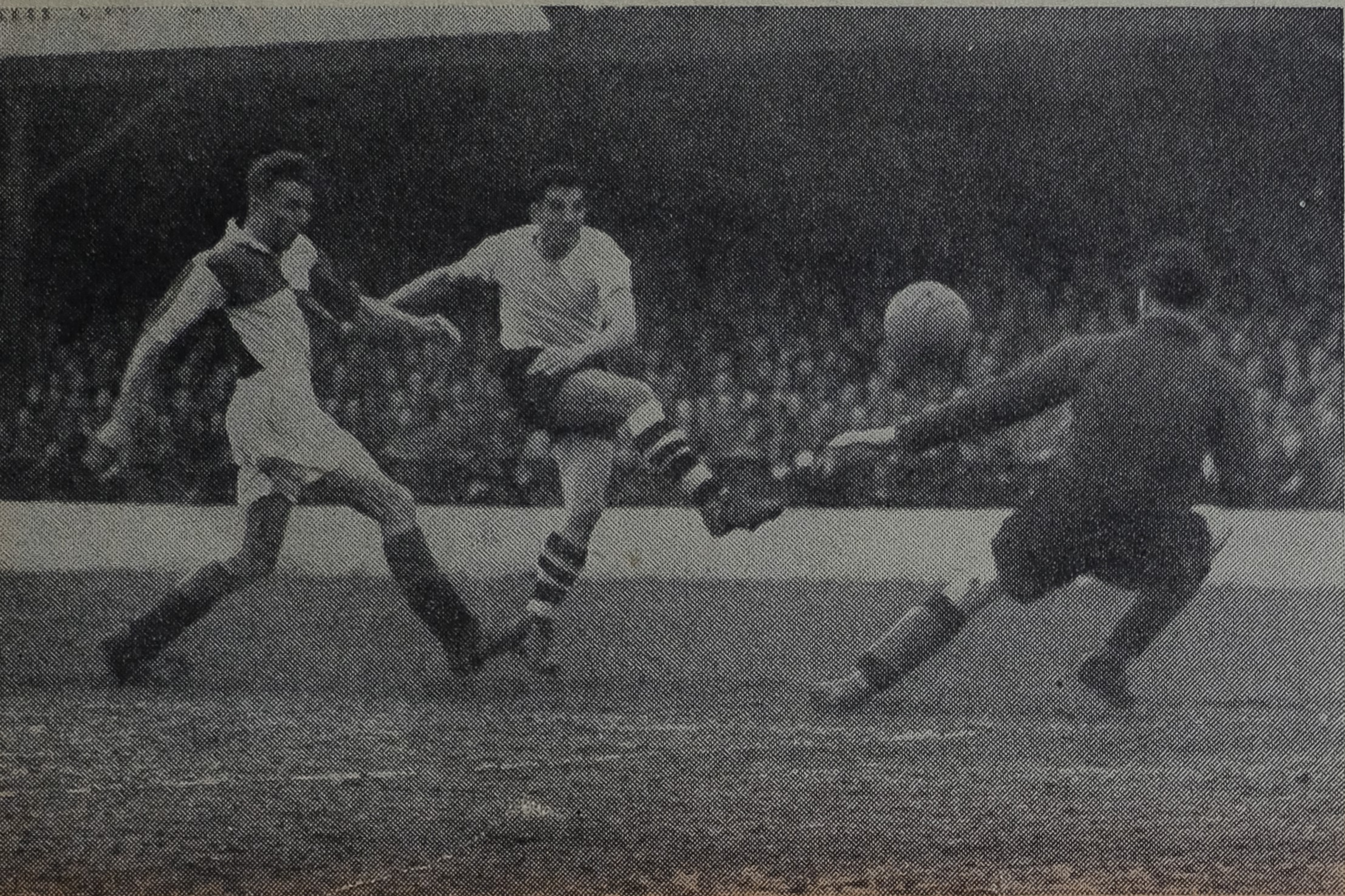


WATKINS (2) GIVES LUTON THE POINT



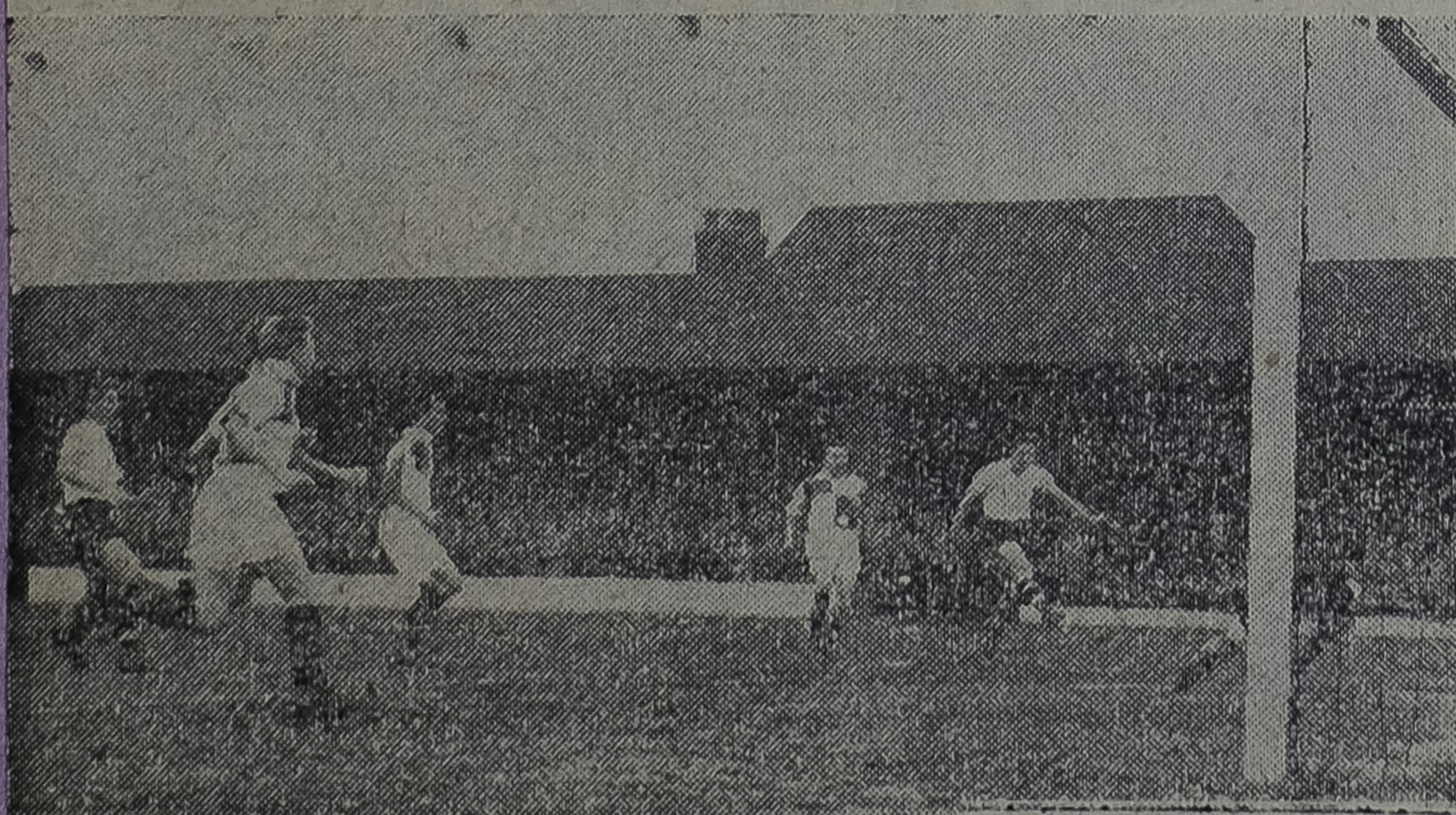

Puzzle—whose legs are who's? Bristol goalkeeper Chandler tops Luton's MacEwan for a high ball inside the goal area.—R8642K

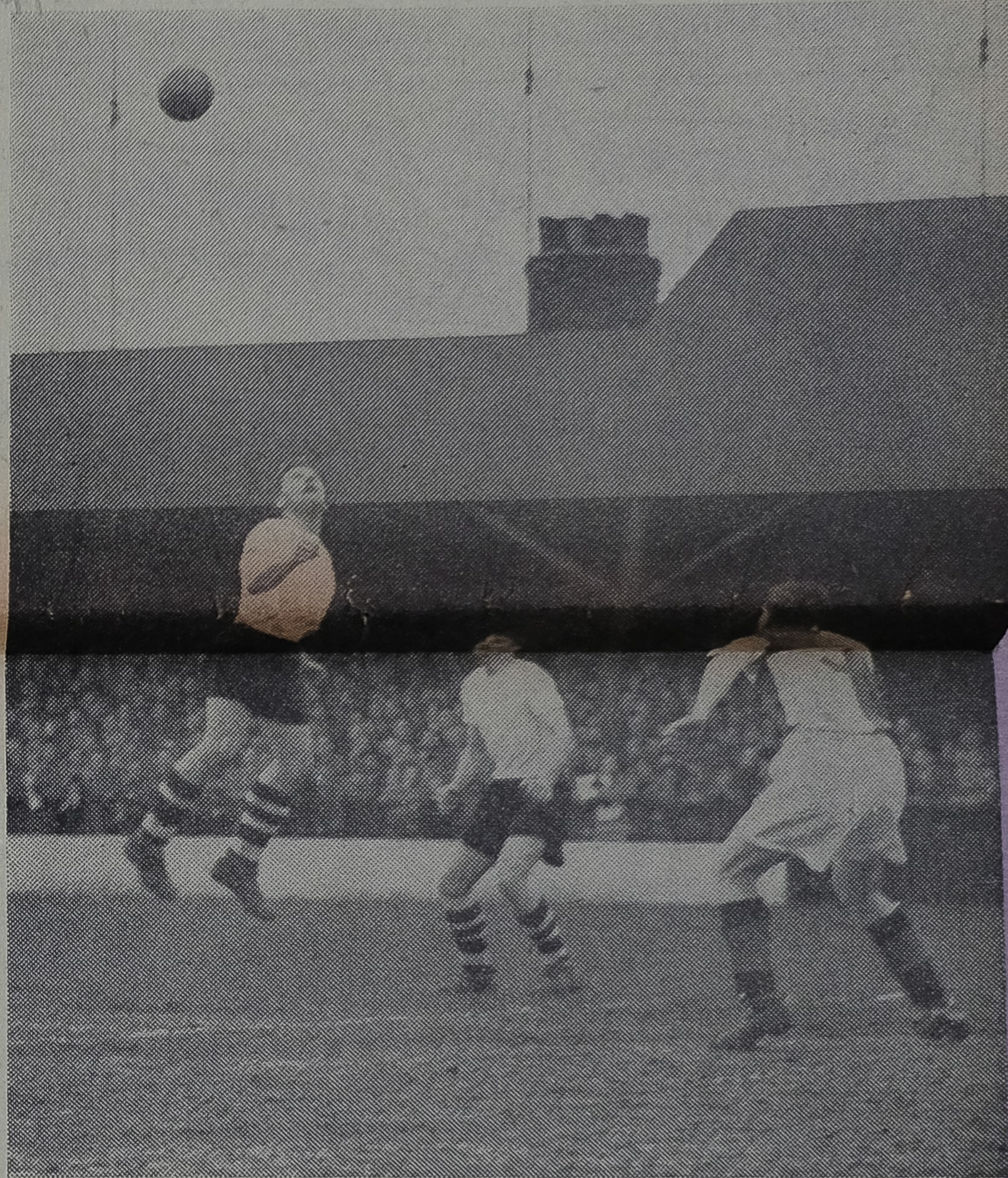


Deflected
