

FLASHBACK TO BOXING DAY

News of the Manchester United air-crash disaster came as a shock to the world. Football fans in Luton remember the last time the Town played this team, which was at Kenilworth-road on Boxing Day. Fielding a scratch team — Baynham, Morton, Owen and Turner were missing, owing to injuries — Luton were two goals down at half-time and seemed to have little hope of securing a point.
