

# *Luton show Leeds how to shoot*

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**L**ATEST training aid to better football at Leeds is a "shooting gallery," but coach Bill Lambton's super-fit footballers didn't win any prizes when they tried their luck against Luton last night.

According to the Elland-road programme, Leeds' training sessions are full of variety and innovation, but somewhere in the schedule for winning matches I suggest they include the words "keep it simple."

Leeds may be fit, but Luton left them streets behind in the basic arts of trapping, passing, and positioning.

## ***Mistake helps***

Shooting was Luton's strong point, personified by inside-right **Gordon Turner**, who deserved more than the 22nd-minute goal a Wilbur Cush mistake helped him to.

It was also Leeds' weak point, and the goal that earned them a draw was a rather shaky 63rd-minute penalty which outside-right **Chris Crowe** slammed in off the underside of the bar.

This put some spirit into Leeds. But I still think a man by the name of George Meek, at present in the reserves, could show them how to win coconuts.
