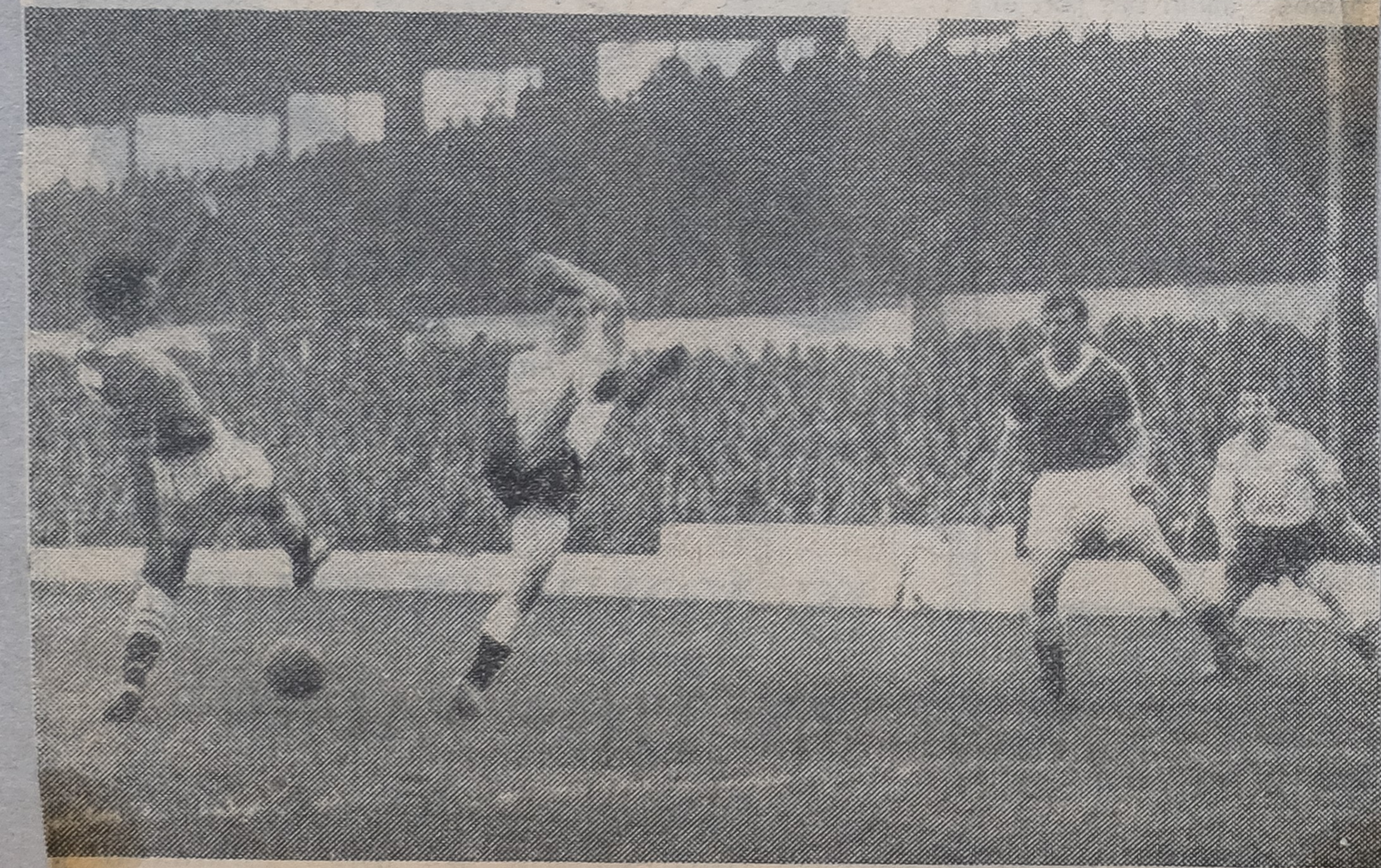


HURLY-BURLY 2-1 WIN



Chelsea played it rough. It wasn't Luton's kind of game, but they matched a tough hurly-burly with skill—and won 2—1. In fact it could have been more. **LEFT:** A goalmouth scramble brings Luton a goal lead in the eighth minute. Chelsea's 'keeper, Matthews, dives at Brown's feet, misses, and the centre-forward punts the ball into the net. — R9363R. **ABOVE:** Brown tries again, leaping to meet a Bingham corner. Luton are piling on the pressure, picking up every chance to tear open a Chelsea defence that isn't giving much away. Matthews jumps to pick a Brown lob out of the air, but the ball slips through his fingers . . . hits a post . . . and lands to Cummins. The inside-forward first-times it back goal, and the ball crashes into an upright!—R9367R.
