# Turner Makes Notable Return To Luton Side

CHOCK for the town this morning was the news that, not only was Ron Baynham unfit because of a boil on an arm, but Allan Brown had to stay in bed because of a sudden attack of tonsillitis.

Alan Collier, 20-years-old former Youth International, came in to make his League debut, and the inside-right vacancy was filled by bringing in 21-years-old Alwyn McGuffie from the reserve team. McGuffie had a spell in the first team last season at right-half, but this is the first time to my knowledge that he has been used as an inside forward.




