

TURNER GRABS 200th GOAL 20/9/61

Middlesbrough2 Luton Town4

LUTON centre-forward Gordon Turner scored his 200th League goal—from the penalty spot—last night in a match which Luton won after twice being behind.

Both sides played good football, but Middlesbrough, leading 2—1 at the interval, faded in the second half.

Sheer bad luck prevented Walden and Fleming scoring in the first five minutes when shots hit Appleby and rebounded to safety.

Then, in the seventh minute, Peacock beat Baynham, but Turner equalised 12 minutes later.

Kaye restored Middlesbrough's lead in the 25th minute.

McKechnie (49, 79) and Turner (penalty) scored Luton's second-half goals.

Luton's attack was always lively, with Walden often beating England full-back Mick McNeil.
