

Luton Take Their Time

Luton 3. Leeds 2 61/62

After a listless opening half Luton rallied and deservedly won the day. Yet Leeds might have held a commanding interval lead if they exploited to the full an ominous gap down the Luton middle.

As it was, the teams changed over level. Legate headed Luton into the lead after eight minutes and Revie equalised with a sizzling cross-drive in the 25th minute.

Luton were much livelier in the second half, and in 56 minutes Fleming curled a shot just under the bar to give the home side a deserved lead.

A minute later came a penalty award against Luton. Referee Leafe insisted that a Luton defender had handled. Bremner scored from the spot.
