

BOSWELL KEEPS LUTON AT BAY

WALSALL DISCOVERY

Walsall ... 2 Luton 0

Walsall have a flair for discovering brilliant goalkeepers. In 18-year-old Alan Boswell, tradition is certainly being maintained.

It would probably be unfair to the rest of the Walsall side to suggest Boswell won the game against Luton on his own but he certainly played a major part.

Early in the second half when Luton threatened to overwhelm the home defence, he remained calm to deal with a succession of well-placed shots.

Having weathered the storm Walsall, a goal ahead after 40 minutes through centre-forward Wilson, regrouped and never looked like conceding a point.

The game was settled 10 minutes from the end when Wilson was allowed to go on from an apparently offside position to run the ball into an empty net.

Luton's goalkeeper Baynham, playing in his track-suit trousers, was the pick of the visitors' side, bringing off a succession of superb clearances in the opening period when Walsall were well on top.
