Disappointing End To The Season

LUTON TOWN completed their League programme for the 1961/62 season at Kenilworth-road on Saturday, when they defeated Bristol Rovers by 2—0.

These two points put them in a disappointingly low 13th position in the Division II table, but Charlton Athletic, who played their final match last night, needed only to win or draw to put the Town down to 14th place.

Of their 42 games, Luton won 17, drew five and lost 20, with a goal average of 69 for and 71 against.
