

# Luton hit the high spots

Luton . . . . . 3 Swansea . . . . . 1

**L**UTON centre - forward Ron Davies scored a hat-trick against Swansea last night.

It eased Luton's relegation worries and brought his goals total to ten in the past six games.

Luton hit their top form here. They forced Swansea straight into defence and took the lead after seven minutes when Davies headed home a Bramwell free-kick. He scored again in the 32nd minute, this time after a pass from Clapton.

Swansea, playing several promising youngsters, were lively in mid-field, but they seldom troubled Luton in the first half.

They came more into the game after the interval, however, and the Luton goal had some lucky escapes until Bramwell broke away in the 71st minute and passed to Davies, who completed his hat-trick after Dwyer had half-saved his first effort.

Swansea hit back immediately and got a consolation goal from Todd after a Thomas header rebounded from the bar.
