#### Club Notes

F.A. CUP glory is not for us this season but those of us who were at Fulham on Saturday had the feeling at half-time that we might well be due for a "break."

This followed by far the best 45 minutes we have experienced away from home this season, and with reasonable luck, we could have been ahead at the change - over.

Had Harry Walden's shot gone in instead of hitting the post, or had other near misses counted, we might, at least, have had the excitement of a replay.

However, it was not to be and there is no doubt in the end that the First Division team deserved their victory and we wish them well in their tough tie at Blackburn.

In our disappointment, we still wish to congratulate our near neighbours, Bedford Town and, in fact, have done so already in writing, on their famous victory at Newcastle.

From experience, we know just how difficult it is to secure anything in the nature of a favourable result at St. Jame's Park and the fact that our former assistant manager, Tim Kelly, one of our ex-assistant trainers. Reg Game and three former players, Mick Collins, Dave Lovell and John Fahy, had a part in it, makes the success all the more pleasureable.

While in congratulatory mood, let us praise our today's opponents, Barnsley, for their notable feat in dismissing Second Division, Scunthorpe Utd., from the F.A. Cup after a replay that went in to extra time.

Only too well we know what formidable opponents the Yorkshire side can be on their own Oakwell ground, which we have been visiting intermittently since before the war. Over the years, there has been the friendliest of relationships between the two clubs and, in view of that, it is rather sad that both are engaged in the search for vital points this afternoon against the spectre of relegation.

Barnsley's record is a little better than ours this season, but the position is that we cannot afford to allow them to pull away from us.

Fortunately, the defence, after the changes made last week, showed new found resiliency and we are hoping that the forward formation chosen, with John Reid fit again, will be able to deliver the goods in the shape of goals.

Next Saturday, we go to Coventry with whom we had some rare old tussles in the years before the war when both clubs were fighting for promotion. Doubtless, with these in mind, we shall have a bigger than usual following for an away match and supporters should note that the kick-off is timed for 3.15.

Before that, we have what we regard as an important match at Kenilworth Road on Wednesday evening, kick-off 7.30, when our youth team meet Northampton Town in the third round of the F.A. Youth Cup, at which stage 32 teams are left.

In recent weeks, our juniors have had a notable run of success, spearheaded by Mick Forsyth, who has scored 14 goals in five matches and, early this week, he signed forms as a part-time professional.

For this match, we shall open only the entrance to the stand and encloseure and admission will be 1/- for adults and 6d. for boys.

Still to be arranged is the replayed South Eastern Counties League Cup semi-final between us and Charlton Ath. which will be played at Kenilworth Road by floodlight.

#### PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Robert Williamson (goalkeeper). Latest recruit at Barnsley. He has had previous experience with St. Mirren and Arbroath and is 28 years old. Bob was born at Edinburgh and released by St. Mirren after being originally retained by them at the end of last season.

Allan Hopper (right back). Allan came to the fore two seasons ago when he reached top form. He was signed from South Shields in February 1961.

Eric Brookes (left back). Eric, a local born player, is also a former Barnsley Schoolboys' player, and a former England Youth International. He became a professional in April 1961, and made his League debut while on the Club Groundstaff.

Bobby Wood (right half and captain). Bobby who joined the Club twelve years ago from Hibermians is a 100% worker and is always ready to try a shot at goal. He has given Barnsley great service.

Eric Winstanley (centre half). Eric who joined the Club Groundstaff from Barnsley Boys' Team is another former England Youth International. He got his chance last season following the retirement of stalwart Duncan Sharp. Eric became a professional in May of last year.

Billy Houghton (left half). Billy, a strong wing half, is another Barnsley born player who graduated through the local schoolboys' team. He is also a former Youth International. He became a professional in May 1957.

Jimmy Sheavills (outside right). Made 23 first team appearances for Peterborough last season, signing for Barnsley in June. He joined Peterborough from Holbeach United in March 1960.

George Kerr (inside forward). George was signed in May 1960, from the Scottish Junior Club Vale Juniors. He is a clever ball player.

Tony Leighton (centre forward). Tony was given a free transfer by Doncaster Rovers at the end of season 1961/62, although the Club's leading goalscorer. Barnsley promptly snapped him up. He is a useful cricketer as well as a thrusting forward.

Hugh Cochrane (inside forward). Hugh is twenty years old and signed forms for Barnsley after being with Dundee United.

Eddie O'Hara (outside left). Eddie was signed in the close season last year from Morton, the Scottish club. He had previously played with Rotherham.
